Please observe the rules and etiquette of golf as set out by the Royal Canadian Golf Association:

## ETIQUETTE

1. Replace divots.
2. Repair ball marks or other damage to greens.
3. Dress code in effect.
4. No fivesomes allowed.
5. No caddy carts on greens.
6. Slow players must signal following players to pass through.
7. Gas carts must stay on cart paths where possible.
8. Keep gas carts 30 feet away from tees and greens.

## LOCAL RULES

Ball lying on any road or ground under repair, lift and drop not nearer to hole. NO PENALTY.

## COURSE REGULATIONS

Equipment area between 10 and 18 to be played as a lateral hazard, penalty 1 stroke, play from point of entry.

No 12 - Ravine is a water hazard.

No 15 - Lateral water hazard to left side of fairway.

Boundary fences on 1, 2, 3, 10, 13, 14.

No 3 - To right of driving area is lateral water hazard.

No 11 - To left of fairway is lateral water hazard.

No 16 - To left of fairway is lateral water hazard.
